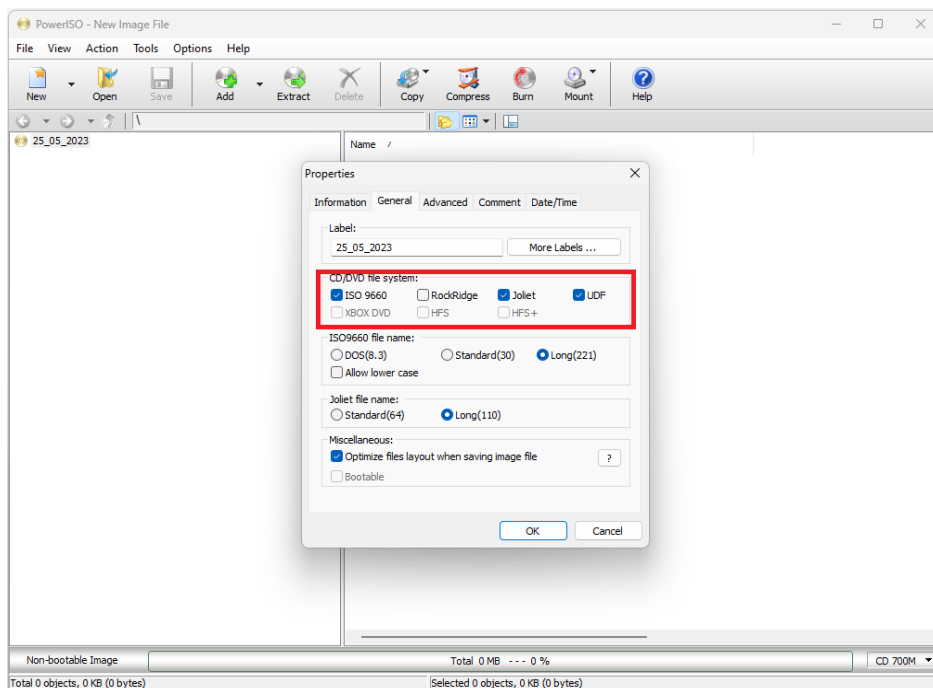
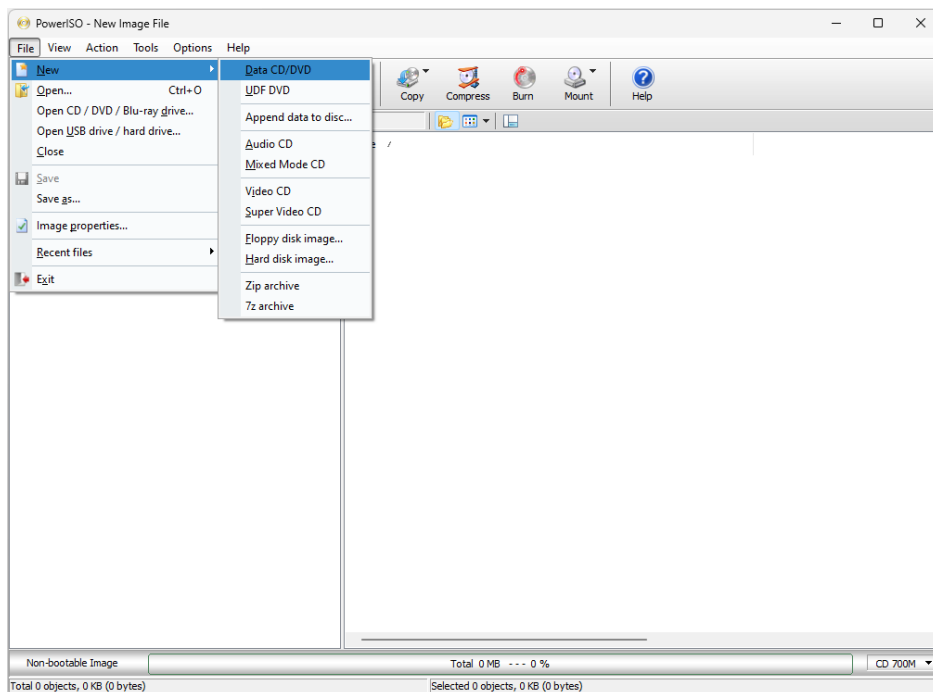

# Burning a BIOS Disc for OpenXenium

## 1

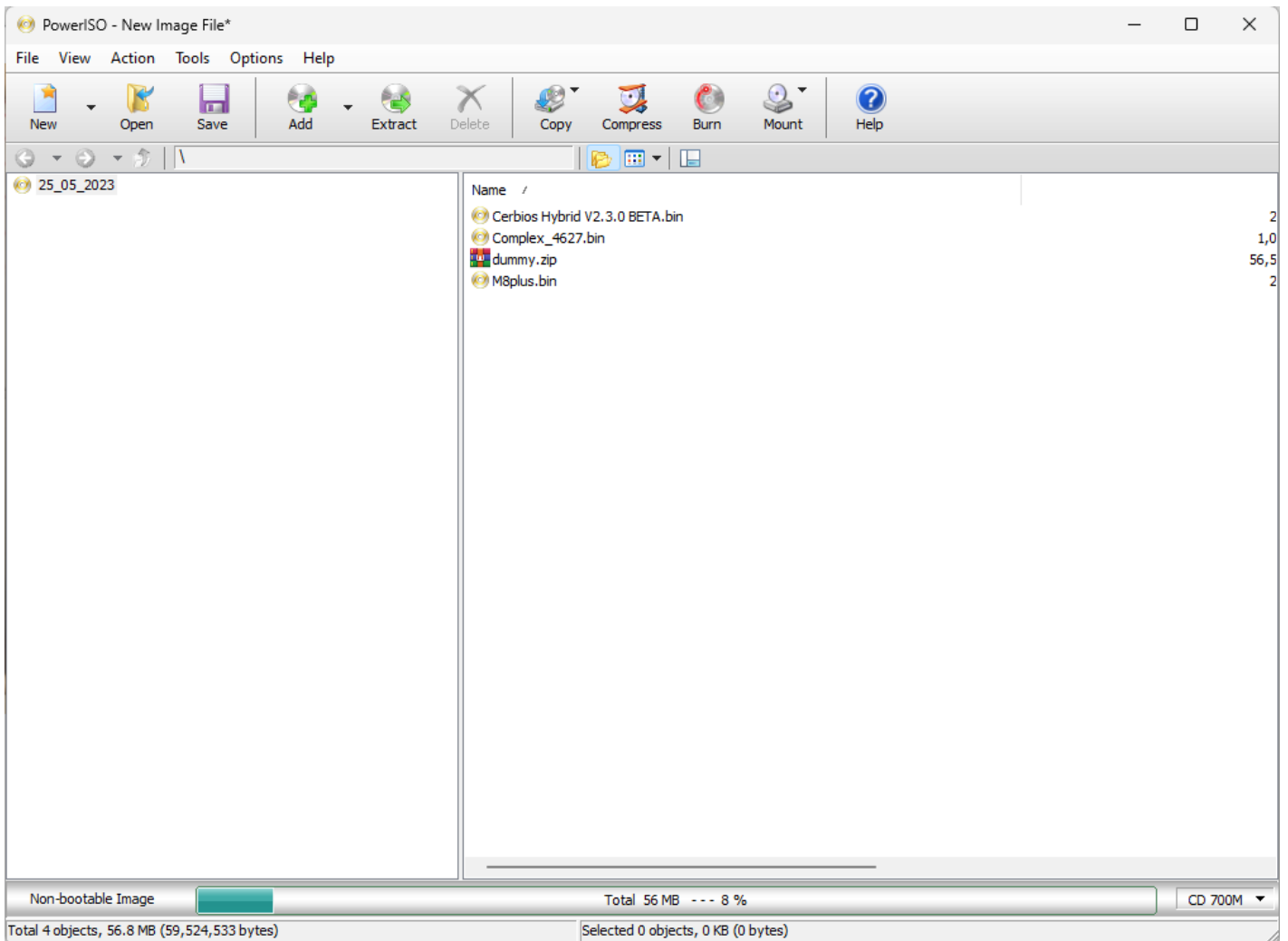
- Open “**PowerISO**” – from the toolbar, select ‘**File**’ > ‘**New**’ > ‘**Data CD/DVD**’.
- Select ‘**File**’ > ‘**Image properties**’ and make sure that the image file system uses both ‘**ISO 9600**’, ‘**Joliet**’ and ‘**UDF**’.



# Burning a BIOS Disc for OpenXenium

## 2

- Drag-and-drop your BIOS images with the extension (.BIN) into the main window. It is highly recommended that you pad the disc image with dummy files to ensure that the Xbox recognises the disc more easily.



# Burning a BIOS Disc for OpenXenium

## 3

- Select the 'Burn' button then make the following options:

Burn speed: 4x up to 8x speed.  
Finalize disc.

- Burn the compilation onto the DVD-R.
